- Working with the functional leads, develop overall project activities, tasks and resource needs, project management plans, risk registers and updates of dashboards to permit ongoing monitoring
- Develop relationship and work closely with sales and marketing team
- Ensure project management activities and tasks are consistent across all other projects and the completion of these on time and on budget
- Proactively identify project risk, analyse solutions, and take decisive action to resolve issues and communicate these to the business
- Present and report on project status/metrics, issues/solutions, risks and project resource needs
- Participate in coordinating / producing cost or schedule recovery / mitigation plans, and monitoring against these
- Participate in effective and efficient business process improvements
- Ensure compliance and adherence to processes and policy requirements
- Drive project processes including monitoring and controlling, and project closeout
- Act as the key interface with external customers for project communication / reporting and interact with subcontractors and cross-functional internal teams as necessary to execute projects
- Follow-up with customers to resolve past due and other commercial issues related to the project and/or contract.
